

## **2015 Regional Placement Testing Program Information for Taking Tests at Another Time**

As a new freshman for fall 2015, you are required to take the English and math placement tests. You are *exempt* from taking the respective placement test(s) **IF** you have completed or are currently taking a transferable *college level* English, math or foreign language course *for credit*. To take the foreign language placement test in French, German or Spanish, you must have two or more years of the language in which you wish to test. There is a possibility for you to earn retroactive credits by taking the UW Oshkosh course you test into and earning a grade of A or B (ask your academic advisor for more details).

You may test anytime the Testing Services Office is open; no appointment is necessary. **You will, however, need to allow enough time to complete the tests by closing time.** You need to complete the placement at least 2 weeks prior to your Odyssey date.

**An additional assessment fee of \$5.00 per placement test will be charged to students at the time of testing for this option.** Cash or check is accepted.

### **UW Oshkosh Testing Services Office hours are as follows:**

**NO placement testing exams will be administered the week of May 11-15 due to finals week at UW Oshkosh**

The time limit for each test is as follows:

Math - 90 minutes
English - 90 minutes
Foreign Language - 60 minutes

On the day you test, please bring a picture ID and a couple of number 2 pencils with a good eraser. You may bring a battery powered scientific calculator to use on the mathematics portion of the test. Graphing calculators will not be permitted, and calculators will not be provided at the test site. You will need a minimum of three hours to complete the math and English tests; an additional 60 minutes if you take the optional foreign language placement test. All tests must be completed prior to closing time.

The Testing Services Office is located in the lower level of Polk Library, Room 4. You may park on any of the adjacent city streets without a permit or park in one of the five (5) Testing Services spots in Lot #34 (corner of Elmwood Avenue and Lincoln Street). You must obtain a parking permit (\$2 per day) from Testing Services for one of these spots. Visitors may also use/plug a parking meter (25 cents per 20 minutes) at various locations around the campus.
