

Articulation Agreement June 16, 2017

1. Transfer Institution: Chippewa Valley Technical College

Degree: Associate of Applied Science

Program:

Criminal Justice

2. Degree Granting Institution: University of Wisconsin Oshkosh

Degree: Bachelor of Applied Studies Program: Criminal Justice major (online)

- 3. Rationale: This agreement is being established in order to expand educational opportunities for graduates of Chippewa Valley Technical College and to strengthen the educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS).
- 4. Chippewa Valley Technical College course/credits accepted in transfer and UW Oshkosh equivalent course/credits:

5. Credits from Chippewa Valley Technical College to transfer to UW Oshkosh: See attachments.

- 6. Other UW Oshkosh academic requirements that the student must satisfy:
 - Earn at least 120 credits.
 - Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
 - Earn at least 30 credits at UW Oshkosh.
 - Earn at least 30 credits from a 4-year institution.
 - Earn at least 35 credits in 300/400 level courses.

Conditions:

- The terms of this agreement apply <u>only</u> for the purposes of entry into the Bachelor of Applied Studies (BAS) degree in Criminal Justice at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree and/or major other than the BAS in Criminal Justice may encounter additional program requirements.
- Students from the above-mentioned Wisconsin Technical College must have successfully completed one of the Associate of Applied Science programs listed in #1 above (fulfilling all coursework stipulated therein) with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 or higher, and have graduated in 1990 or later, in order for inclusion under this agreement. The terms of the agreement do <u>not</u> apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for the Associate degree.
- 7. Effective date: July 01, 2017
- 8. Review date: This agreement will be reviewed in June 2020 and updated or extended at that time.
