1. Transfer Institution: Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC)

Degree: Associate of Applied Science

Programs: Fire Protection Technician
Paramedic Technician
Criminal Justice Studies

2. Degree Granting Institution: University of Wisconsin Oshkosh (UWO)

Degree: Bachelor of Applied Studies

Programs: Fire & Emergency Response Management (Major) – Fire Services Management (Emphasis)
Fire & Emergency Response Management (Major) – Emergency Management (Emphasis)

3. Rationale

This agreement is being established in order to expand educational opportunities for graduates of Milwaukee Area Technical College and to strengthen the educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS).

4. Transfer Agreement – General Studies

UWO and MATC have an existing “General Studies Transfer Agreement” that identifies the transfer of specific general education, elective, and competency credits from Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC) to the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh. These courses, taken as part of or in conjunction with, the Associate of Applied Science programs identified above, will transfer to UW Oshkosh as designated through the “General Studies Transfer Agreement.” See *Attachment 1: General Studies Transfer*

5. Associate Degree Block Credits

A block of up to 45 credits will be awarded at admission into the Fire and Emergency Response Management major for completion of the Associate of Applied Science program in the programs designated through this articulation agreement at Milwaukee Area Technical College.

6. Other UW Oshkosh academic requirements

The following are additional UWO academic requirements that a transfer student must satisfy to earn a Bachelors degree:

- Earn at least 120 credits.
- Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
- Earn at least 30 credits at UW Oshkosh.
- Earn at least 30 credits from a 4-year institution.
- Earn at least 35 credits in 300/400 level courses.

7. Conditions

The terms of this agreement apply only to students accepted into the Bachelor's of Applied Studies (BAS) degree at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree other than the BAS may encounter additional program requirements and may not be eligible for the block of credits.

Students from the Milwaukee Area Technical College must have successfully completed their Associate of Applied Science program in Fire Protection Technician, Paramedic Technician, or Criminal Justice Studies (fulfilling all coursework stipulated therein) with a graduating grade point average of 2.5 or higher, and have graduated in 1990 or later, in order to be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. These terms do not apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for this Associate degree.

8. Effective Date: September 2022

9. Review Date: This agreement will be reviewed in July 2025 and updated or extended at that time.
