

# Articulation Agreement 2022

1. Transfer Institution: Milwaukee Area Technical College

Degree: Technical Diploma

Programs: Aviation Technician – Airframe;

Aviation Technician – Powerplant

2. Degree Granting Institution: University of Wisconsin Oshkosh (UWO)

Degree: Bachelor of Applied Studies

Programs: Leadership & Organizational Studies (Major) – Aviation Management (Emphasis)

#### 3. Rationale

This agreement establishes an educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and Milwaukee Area Technical College to expand the opportunities for their graduates to complete an aviation management bachelor's degree.

- **4. Communication:** Milwaukee Area Technical College and the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh agree to cooperate in communicating with each other and with their common and respective publics concerning the established relationship between the two institutions.
  - a. Any marketing of the articulation agreement in print will be subject to the prior approval of both schools. Each institution will assume responsibility for appropriate marketing to reach their respective student and faculty populations.
  - b. Faculty and staff at both will communicate information about this agreement to students and prospective students.
  - c. Milwaukee Area Technical College will provide, at its website, a link to the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh website.



# 5. Technical Diploma Degree Block Credits

A block of up to 45 credits will be awarded at admission into the Leadership & Organizational Studies-Aviation Management program for completion of both technical diplomas in Aviation Technician – Airframe & Aviation Technician – Powerplant designated through this articulation agreement at Milwaukee Area Technical College.

#### 6. Other UW Oshkosh academic requirements

The following are additional UWO academic requirements that a transfer student must satisfy to earn a Bachelor's degree:

- Earn at least 120 credits.
- Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
- Earn at least 30 credits at UW Oshkosh.
- Earn at least 30 credits from a 4-year institution.
- Earn at least 35 credits in 300/400 level courses.

## 7. Conditions

The terms of this agreement apply only to students accepted into the Bachelor of Applied Studies (BAS) degree at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree other than the BAS may encounter additional program requirements and may not be eligible for the block of credits.

Students from the Milwaukee Area Technical College must have successfully completed their Technical Diploma in Aviation Technician – Airframe; & Aviation Technician – Powerplant in 1990 or later, in order to be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. These terms do not apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for these two technical diplomas.

**8. Effective Date:** September 2022

**9. Review Date:** This agreement will be reviewed in August 2025 and updated or extended at that time.
