

Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement

2022

Klamath Community College and the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh wish to facilitate the transfer of Klamath Community College students to the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Bachelor of Applied Studies in Aviation Management. University of Wisconsin Oshkosh is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission.

1. Degree Granting Institution: University of Wisconsin Oshkosh

Degree: Bachelor of Applied Studies

Program: Aviation Management emphasis of Leadership & Organizational Studies major

2. Transfer Institution: Klamath Community College

Degree: Applied Associates Degree

Program: Aviation Airplane

3. **Effective Date:** September 1st, 2022

4. Review Date: August 1st, 2025

- Explanation and Rationale: This agreement establishes an educational partnership between UW
 Oshkosh and Klamath Community College in order to expand the opportunities for their
 graduates to complete an aviation management bachelor's degree.
- 6. **Communication:** Klamath Community College and the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh agree to cooperate in communicating with each other and with their common and respective publics concerning the established relationship between the two institutions.
 - a. Any marketing of the articulation agreement in print will be subject to the prior approval of both schools. Each institution will assume responsibility for appropriate marketing to reach their respective student and faculty populations.
 - b. Faculty and staff at both will communicate information about this agreement to students and prospective students.
 - c. Klamath Community College will provide, at its website, a link to the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh website.
- 7. Klamath Community College students who have successfully completed the above program will be awarded **a block of 45 credits**, based on related technical coursework and required general

- education courses (see below) which will be applied to the BAS degree in Aviation Management with UW Oshkosh.
- 8. UW Oshkosh will consider credits for general education and other courses for transfer on a caseby-case basis
- 9. Block credits will be awarded based on successful completion of the following:

10. **Review and Modification of the Agreement:** each institution will notify the other of any contemplated curricular changes that would affect this agreement.

- 11. **Conditions:** The terms of this agreement apply <u>only</u> to students accepted into the Bachelor of Applied Studies AM degree program at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree other than the BAS AM may encounter additional program requirements.
 - a. Students from the above-mentioned Klamath Community College program must have successfully completed their Associate degree (fulfilling all course work stipulated therein) with a graduating grade point average of 2.5 or higher in order to be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. The terms of this agreement do <u>not</u> apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for this Associate degree.
 - b. Other UW Oshkosh academic requirements that the student must satisfy:
 - i. Earn at least 120 credits.
 - ii. Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher.
 - iii. Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher in English composition courses.
 - iv. Earn at least 30 credits at UW Oshkosh.
 - v. Earn at least 30 credits from a 4-year institution.
 - vi. Earn at least 35 credits in 300/400 level courses.
- 12. **Exchange of Information:** UWO and Klamath Community College agree to exchange transfer student information for the purpose of monitoring and enhancing student success. The information may also be used to enhance curricula offerings. At no time will family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) regulations or requirements be violated.
