

UARC Summer Highlights

The UARC Staff had a strategic planning retreat this summer facilitated by Dr. Tracy Slagter from the Political Science Department. As a result, we identified four strategic priorities: student empowerment, faculty partnerships, partner collaboration, and administration's value of advising. To address these priorities the UARC formed four task forces: advisor schedules, documentation, communication, and faculty partnerships and outreach. The goal of each task force is to promote and improve advising outcomes as they relate to our strategic priorities.

In addition to developing a strategic plan we continued to advise students throughout the summer. One of the largest populations of students we work with in the summer is incoming transfer students. This summer we had one-hour intake appointments with more than 530 incoming transfer students. In addition, during New Student Advisement and Registration, we individually advised (with the help of SSS advisors) more than 1,500 incoming freshmen over the course of 12 days.

SSC Training

In September we will offer more SSC training opportunities for faculty advisors. There will be two different types of training with four sessions of each. The first will be for individuals who have not yet attended an SSC training, or those who have but would like a refresher. The second training offered will focus on using the calendar and campaign features of SSC to schedule advising appointments.
