

## January 2019 Snapshot

### Academic Standing

Academic Standing is determined by the UWO Official GPA which is made up of UWO grades only. Students are placed on probation or suspension following the 14-week term when they fail to satisfy the good standing requirement of 2.0 UW Oshkosh Official GPA and above a 1.0 term GPA. However, if by the end of the 17th week of a term, additional coursework has been completed and/or a grade(s) has been changed which improves the student's academic record, the status can be reviewed and adjusted appropriately.

Students were notified of their probation or suspension status via e-mail on December 21st. Probationary status does not require any formal action. Suspended students were given the opportunity to submit an appeal by January 8th to continue attending UW Oshkosh in the spring term. Students were notified January 17th if their appeal had been granted. The suspension appeal decision is final.

The GPA listed on the SSG Student Profile is the UW Oshkosh Official GPA (UW Oshkosh grades only) and not the Combined GPA (UW Oshkosh and transfer grades) as described when you hover over the category.

The Student Profile now shows the current GPA. Previously, this GPA was only updated after the completion of the 17 weeks of the semester (after interim).

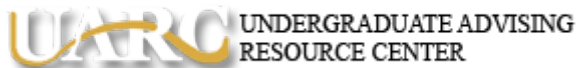
