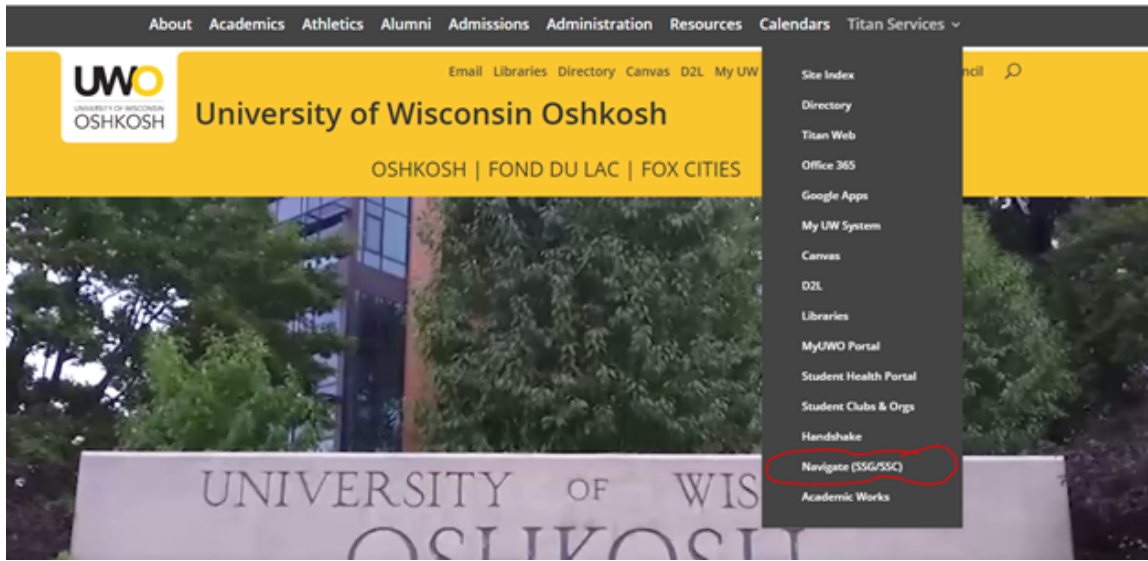
### What's New in Advising?
