English & Math Changes

As you start to advise for Fall 2020 be aware of changes to English/WBIS and PBIS courses.

**Note: Advanced Composition courses will no longer count towards upper level credits (except for Honors Comp)*

PBIS188 to MATH188 PBIS: Math and your Political World (XM)
PBIS189 to MATH189 PBIS: Statistics (XM)

How this affects students:

1. Advisement Reports for students with bulletin years prior to Fall 2020 will still show the old requirement departments/numbers, but students will no longer find these “old” courses on Titan Web. When taken, the new courses will appear in the correct area of the Advisement Report.
2. Students who have been advised that Advanced Composition will count towards upper level credits, but have not yet completed the requirement, will need to satisfy these upper level credits with another course.
3. Students who really need this requirement to count as upper level credits have one last chance to take it online this summer through OCE as English 300 or 312. These classes will no longer be offered or exist starting in Fall 2020.

Summer Course Options

Many students choose to take a summer course to stay on track for graduation. In addition to our on campus (face to face) courses, other options include our on-line courses, UW Independent Learning (UW IL) self-paced courses, or courses at other institutions closer to their home. On-line Course Options

There are three types of on-line courses in Titan Web. Each type has different steps for enrollment.

1) Oshkosh Campus traditional online courses

- Oshkosh home campus students may enroll in these courses without permission
- Fox Cities and Fond du Lac campus students must complete the [Student Guest Form](#) for permission to enroll and are subject to additional tuition charges
- There is a \$50 per credit distance learning fee assessed for these courses.

- Fox Cities and Fond du Lac home campus students may enroll in these courses without permission
- Oshkosh campus students need to email uwcco@uwosh.edu for permission to enroll
- Additional tuition will be charged for Oshkosh campus students (the cost of tuition is NOT included in the price charged for 12-18 credits for full-time students during the 14 week semesters)
- These courses may also vary from the UWO course calendar

- Additional tuition will be charged for these courses (the cost of tuition is NOT included in the price charged for 12-18 credits for full-time students during the 14 week semesters)

UW Independent Learning

Students choosing to take courses through UW Independent Learning can tie those courses to their spring or fall semester for tuition purposes. Students can have their UW IL tuition waived if they are enrolled in at least 12 credits at UW Oshkosh and will not go over 18 credits with the additional UW IL course.
