Fall Enrollment Dates Delayed

Departments and instructors were given more time to make decisions about the Mode of Instruction for fall classes. Therefore, registration dates were delayed and there will be more students registering each day in April. Fall registration dates and classes were opened for students to view in TitanWeb on March 8.

April 5-9	Seniors; 90+ credits earned and priority registration
April 12-16	Juniors; 60-89 credits earned
April 19-23	Sophomores; 30-59 credits earned
April 26-30	Freshmen; 0-29 credits earned

What can students see in Navigate?

- A link to [Schedule an Appointment](#) with their assigned advisor if the advisor has Availability set up in Navigate

- Their [Success Team](#) which includes assigned advisor(s), coaches, and Team Fellows (academic support volunteers for athletes, also shown as “Coach” role)
- Many first-year students also have the Navigate Student App which has many of these same features and more. It was introduced last summer. Reports (listed in the first two bullets above) created Jan. 26, 2021 or later are visible in the app for 6 months.

Application for Graduation; Timeline and Process

In general, Graduation Applications are due by the end of the semester prior to their graduation term (when they will be completing all requirements). Students get an automated confirmation email usually within 24 hours of applying for graduation telling them to check their Advisement Report for deficiencies and work with their advisor to resolve them. This gives students the opportunity to adjust their classes if they have unmet requirements.

When students have 79.99 credits earned, they receive a link to apply in TitanWeb. They access it as follows:

1. Go to [Titan Web Student Service Center](#)
2. Select [My Academics](#)
3. In the Graduation section of the My Academics page, select "Apply to Graduate"

Students who are completing an Associate Degree will have the link to apply for graduation added after they earn 30 credits.
