What's New in the UARC

Same Day Service: 10-minute Consultations (*formerly known as drop-ins*)

This year students will be able to call or stop by the UARC (920-424-1268, SSC202) to reserve a time to meet with an advisor for a 10-minute consultation that same day. This replaces drop-ins, where students had to sign in and wait to be seen. Think of it like a “fast pass” for quick advising questions.

Same Day Service (SDS) is not meant for semester planning, but rather for completing forms, Advisement Report errors, and registration issues. This service is available to students assigned to faculty advisors who have already met with their assigned advisor and have additional/general/follow up questions.

What's New in Navigate

Meeting Types

Recognizing the ongoing demand for virtual appointments, Navigate now allows advisors to create Availability for in-person and virtual appointments and students to select how they want to meet with their advisor. The UARC is using this feature for all advising services, allowing students to choose if they will meet in-person in the UARC or virtually via MS Teams.

If you schedule advising appointments via Navigate you must create/edit your Availability to include a Meeting Type or else students will not be able to schedule with you.
