3. All programs are approved by the Department of Public Instruction.

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## Admission Requirements

### Teacher Education (BSE) (BFA) (BME)

1. 2.75 GPA minimum and 26 credits earned
2. C or higher in Public Speaking
3. One of:
  - a. 22 ACT
  - b. C in College Level Math and B in Writing

### Direct Admission

1. High School or transfer institution GPA of at least a 3.25+  
AND one of the following:
  - a. Minimum Composite Score of 22 on the ACT test
  - b. Minimum sub-score of 530 on mathematics, 500 on reading and writing for the SAT test

### Human Services Leadership (BS)

1. Declare HSL Major
2. 56 Completed Credits
3. Combined GPA of 2.5

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## Math Progression
