- Completion of USP coursework and about 60 credits earned by the end of the application term
- □ 2.5 minimum Pre-Social Work Foundation GPA
- 2.75 minimum Social Work Gateway GPA
- □ Minimum of 50 hours of volunteer work
- □ <u>Application</u> = spring term only for a fall term start
- □ <u>Program</u> = 2 academic years (4 sem.) once admitted
