Anthro 363: Archaeological Analysis

Anthro 363 will give you the opportunity to work hands-on with artifacts - from 10,000 year old items from the first Paleoindian inhabitants of the region to recent historical finds from European colonization. Students will undertake new analyses of a variety of artifacts including jewelry, household items, weapons, grave goods, and animal bones. This course will cover traditional materials analysis from initial recording all the way to museum curation. The course will also include advances in the field including 3D modeling and digital public archaeology. **This course meets the methods requirement for Anthro majors** and will also help majors prepare for their capstone project.
