How to Understand the States of CAPP Registration

CAPP registration forms move through several different states as part of the review process.

Here is an explanation of the states from in the order they will appear (some states may not be needed).

- **Needs Eligibility:** Your high school will be providing us with GPA information to determine eligibility.
- **Waiting for Approval:** Your eligibility has been added, and is pending review by your high school teacher.
- **Needs Liaison Approval:** You do not meet our eligibility requirements, but your teacher has made an appeal to their UWO faculty liaison.
- **Appending Approval:** Your registration form is pending review by the UWO faculty liaison for your high school class.
- **Waiting for CAPP Approval:** The CAPP Office does a final review to make sure all previous steps have been completed.
 - If a step was missed, your form will be returned to the necessary state above.
- **Approved Archive:** Your course registration has been fully approved! It is waiting to be sent to the Registrar's Office for official enrollment.

- **Sent for Enrollment:** Your course registration is with the Registrar's Office and you will see your official enrollment on TitanWeb within a couple days.
- **Rejected Archive:** Your course registration has not been approved by one of the above parties. You may contact the CAPP Office with questions.
