All business majors must complete one of the following in order to fulfill the GKR degree requirement.

1) Complete one of the following courses (GKR designated)

2) Study Abroad/Away (one semester or more, non-business focus)

Students may enroll in courses offered at a host university for a single semester or full year. Once returned, students must submit a learning portfolio to the Globalization Committee for review. A portfolio should contain the course syllabus, samples of completed assignments, and a reflection essay on experience abroad, and a description of how the course met the Global Knowledge Requirement learning objectives. Students should submit the portfolio and curriculum modification form to the Undergraduate Office in Sage 1608.

3) Study Abroad program (less than one semester, only 300/400 level course, non-business focus)

Upon the return from the trip, students must enroll in the first seven weeks of MHR 375 Global Management (1.5 credits). Student submits add/drop card for MHR 375 (1.5 credit option), syllabus, trip description, and other relevant information to the Undergraduate Office in Sage 1608.
