Teacher candidates who do not pass the appropriate Praxis Core Assessments or do not meet the Standard Program Admission Requirements may be granted Admission to the COEHS Teacher Education Program by meeting all of the following requirements:

Submitting this cover page with student information added (see below) and the requested information attached.

Enrollment in coursework at UW Oshkosh during the term when you apply

Licensure area(s) [major] declared

A or B (Check one) Documentation for status as a student with (a) an identified disability or an educational disadvantage or (b) a justified rationale for not meeting requirements

Earned 2.50 Combined Grade Point Average

Copy of your current STAR

A written statement listing the resources and services used to retake or correct the areas of concern

Letters of support from two undergraduate faculty

Documentation must be submitted to the COEHS Office by the October 1 or March 1 application deadlines. Contact the teachered@uwosh.edu if you have questions.

Exceptions requests will be reviewed and a decision will be returned to you via email within 10 business days for the deadline. If approved, you will then need to complete the application process through Tk20, including successful completion of a Criminal Background Check review and a clear TB Test.
