

## GRADUATE CERTIFICATE | LEADERSHIP FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE

The University of Wisconsin Oshkosh provides flexible graduate programs that meet your goals and interests. All courses are offered in formats designed to accommodate the working professionals' schedule, including evening and weekend classes in hybrid delivery.

The Leadership for Social Justice graduate certificate affords students (K-12 educators, post-secondary professionals and community members) the opportunity to engage in transformational processes that explore the issues of diversity, equity and respect through a social justice lens. Coursework integrates theoretical, conceptual knowledge with experience and practice-based knowledge.

### ACTIVE LEARNING

Certificate courses are conducted as participatory seminars. As a participant in the program, you will engage in discussions, interactive/experiential activities and share reflections with other learners. Certificate is a fully recognized credential that will appear on official UW Oshkosh transcripts.

### RELEVANCE TO PRACTICE

Assignments and learning activities are designed to encourage participants to address relevant issues and challenges from your own professional practice.
