

ADMINISTRATIVE LICENSES | PK-12 PRINCIPAL AND DIRECTOR OF INSTRUCTION

The University of Wisconsin Oshkosh provides flexible graduate programs that meet your goals and interests. All courses are offered in formats designed to accommodate the working professionals' schedule, including evening and weekend classes in hybrid delivery.

LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS

- Three years of successful, full-time classroom teaching or work as a school counselor, school psychologist or school social worker with at least 540 hours of successful classroom experience.
- Administrative licensures require a Master's degree which can be earned concurrently.
- Students entering without a master's degree must also complete EdL 786 Applied Research to earn the Master of Science in Educational Leadership and Policy Degree concurrently with licensure completion.

COMMUNITY LEARNING

Assignments and activities are designed to encourage stimulating dialogue and practice-based learning with other PK-12 educators.

COMPLETE BOTH PROGRAMS

Candidates completing both licensures programs will take the core courses as well as the additional separate licensure courses EdL 737 and 764. Two internships will be required and students will determine their emphasis.

- **Principal Licensure Emphasis**
A 3-credit internship focused on the Principalship will be completed first with a 2-credit internship focused on Director of Instruction completed as secondary internship.
- **Director Licensure Emphasis**
A 3-credit internship focused on the Director of Instruction will be completed first with a 2-credit internship focused on Principalship completed as a secondary internship.

RELEVANCE TO PRACTICE

The program is fully certified through the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. Participants will be eligible for the PK-12 Principal and/or Director of Instruction licensure.

- EdL 764 | Community Engagement for Educational Institutions
- EdL 793 (3 credits, 1st license) OR EdL 790 (2 credits, 2nd license)
