

SAMPLE COURSE SCHEDULE: ESL/Bilingual Education Licensure (19/22 credits)

Semester	Course Title	Course Description
Summer I 3 credits	ENGLISH 583 - Introduction to English Linguistics (3 credits) distance/online	An introduction to sounds, word forms and sentence structures of English. Special emphasis on theories of grammar affecting today's classroom.
Fall I 6 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 546 - Methods of Teaching English as a Second Language (3 credits)	Explore different methods, strategies and activities in the instruction of English Learners.
	ELEM/ SEC ED 751 - Authentic Assessment for ESL/Bilingual Education (3 credits)	This course will focus on developments in authentic placement, diagnostic and achievement language assessment, and the use of portfolio and performance assessment with English language learners.
Spring I 6 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 548 - Principles of Bilingual/Bicultural Education (3 credits)	This course explores historical and political dimensions of bilingual/bicultural education and discusses practical implications of research for those who work with bilingual/bicultural children, adolescents, families and communities.
	ELEM/SEC ED 552 - ESL and Multicultural Materials, Elementary/Secondary (3 credits)	This course serves as a continuation of the study of sheltered immersion approaches to teaching English Learners, and explores a variety of materials appropriate for age and fluency levels.
Summer II 3-6 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 716 – Contemporary Issues: Working with Diverse Linguistic Communities (3 credits)	This course designed to familiarize educators and others with historical, cultural and educational issues relevant to specific immigrant and refugee communities who reside in Wisconsin. Course content can be made specific to meet the needs of local districts.
	ELEM/SEC ED 549 – Content Area Bilingual Instruction	This course is designed to prepare bilingual educators with theory and practice of content area teaching and biliteracy development in their dual language learners (<i>Bilingual Education license only</i>)
Fall II 1-3 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 794 - Practicum (1-3 credits) in classroom	Supervised on-the-job experience in an educational setting structured to meet the needs of the graduate student.

Summer II 3 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 770: Educational Research online	An introduction to educational research including quantitative and qualitative approaches.
Fall II 3 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 790 – Issues in PK-Schools: Action Research I online	This is part one of a year-long individual research project including proposal, literature review, methodology and approval of data collection.
Spring III 3 credits	ELEM/SEC ED 791- Issues in PK-Schools: Action Research II online	This is part two of a year-long individual research project including data collection, analysis, and writing of a research report/thesis.
