

## LETTER OF PROGRAM MEMORANDUM FOR PE 482 UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN OSHKOSH

This memorandum details the agreement between the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education and sites where candidates are enrolled in the class PE 482.

The Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education will expect the following of the teacher candidate while at the site:

- Practice physical education methodologies when teaching all students with disabilities.
- Demonstrate effective teaching behaviors within the classroom.
- Reflect on field experiences.
- Observe, analyze, and assess students in the physical activity setting.
- Prescribe adapted physical education services based on empirical data.
- Write reports delineating student progress.
- Advocate for disability sport.

The site will provide the following:

- An opportunity to teach students that have a developmental disability in the adapted physical education setting.
- An opportunity to assess students in the physical activity setting.
- An individual qualified to evaluate the students' performance using the evaluation instrument provided.
