This memorandum details the agreement between the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Department of Special & Early Childhood Education and sites where candidates are enrolled in the class SPEC ED 415 - Early Childhood Clinical Three: Primary Field Experience- Special Education.

The Department of Special & Early Childhood Education will expect the following of the teacher candidate while at the site:

- Complete 75 hours - Designed to give the teacher candidate an opportunity to learn about and experience daily roles and responsibilities in a kindergarten, primary and/or special education classroom as a special education teacher. Each teacher candidate is required to complete a placement, serving children five to eight years old.

The site will provide the following:

- Cooperating teacher must complete final evaluation.
