

## LETTER OF PROGRAM MEMORANDUM FOR SPEC ED 462 CLINICAL IN SPECIAL EDUCATION: FOCUS ON TEACHING STUDENTS WITH SIGNIFICANT DISABILITIES UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN OSHKOSH DEPARTMENT OF SPECIAL & EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

This memorandum details the agreement between the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Department of Special & Early Childhood Education and sites where candidates are enrolled in the class SPEC ED 462 - Clinical in Special Education: Focus on Teaching Students with Significant Disabilities.

The Department of Special & Early Childhood Education will expect the following of the teacher candidate while at the site:
