PRAXIS II and ACTFL

The **PRAXIS II** or **ACTFL** tests are required if your combined GPA is below a 3.0 prior to student teaching. These assessments focus on your knowledge of the subject matter you will be teaching. You should register to take this test once you have completed most of your content preparation and feel competent with your subject matter. These are not easy tests and do require preparation.

Plan ahead to register for the test early enough to allow for the possibility of retesting. UWO will not be able to recommend you for a teaching license if you do not pass the appropriate content assessment.

Some tests are offered continuously while other are offered in testing windows that occur several times a year. You may take the Praxis II exam at any test site in Wisconsin where the test is being offered. Test dates fill up quickly. Foreign Language Majors and Minors are required to take the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) tests for Teacher Licensure. Language Testing International (LTI) administers these tests. Please visit the LTI website at www.languagetesting.com for helpful information about these tests. Test fee is approximately \$140.
