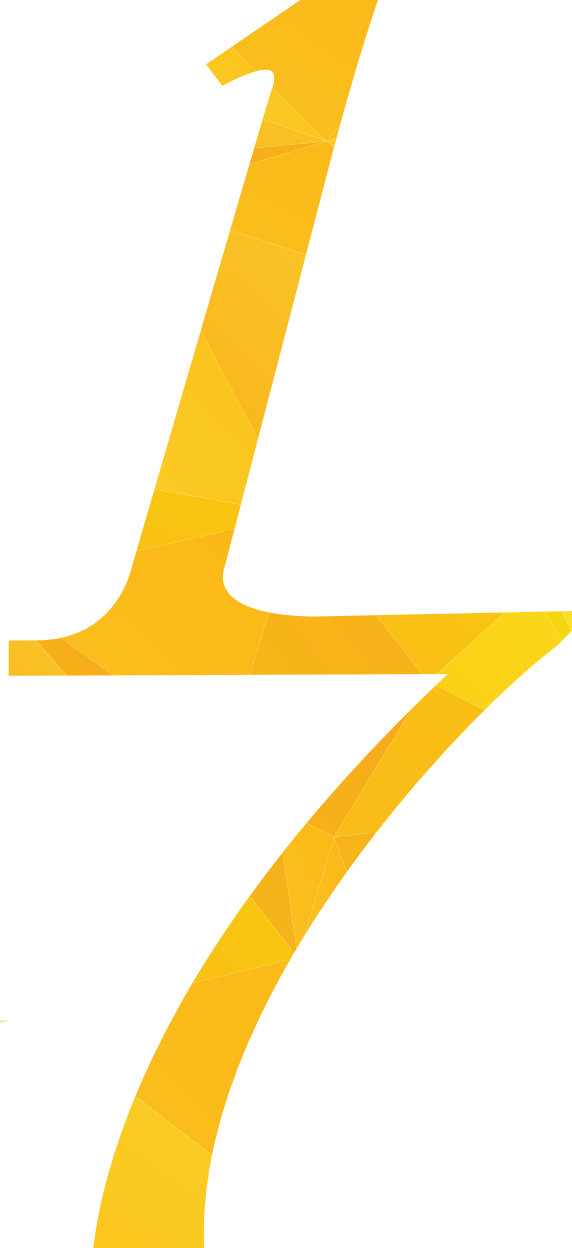

UNIVERSITY *of* WISCONSIN OSHKOSH

The University of Wisconsin Oshkosh was founded as the state's third normal school in 1871. The Oshkosh State Normal School became the state's foremost teacher-training institution.

In later years, as the focus and curriculum expanded, the institution underwent several name changes. A graduate school was added in 1963. In its centennial year of 1971, President Roger Earl Guiles guided UW Oshkosh's merger into the Wisconsin system.

Today, UW Oshkosh prepares students for fulfilling lives and challenging careers with 60 undergraduate majors and

more than 35 master's degree, certificate, doctoral and graduate achievement programs spanning a wide array of disciplines.

Chancellor Andrew J. Leavitt leads this vibrant educational institution under a new strategic plan with a renewed focus on research. The picturesque and environmentally conscious campus covers 173.5 acres and is home to four colleges — Business, Education and Human Services, Letters and Science, and Nursing. UW Oshkosh's focus on teaching is evident in its distinction of having won 10 UW System Regents Teaching Awards of Excellence.

UW Oshkosh is committed to student success, academic excellence, community engagement and economic development.

UNIVERSITY *of* WISCONSIN SYSTEM

The University of Wisconsin System is governed by the Board of Regents, an 18-member board appointed by the governor. The board, in turn, appoints the system president, the chancellors of the 13 universities, the chancellor of Extension and UW Colleges, and the deans of the 13 colleges. The current system president is Ray Cross.

Within the new space, College of Nursing students have access to new labs featuring spaces for students to work with faculty in hands-on situations, a simulation suite set up to replicate a hospital setting, a community simulation apartment for students to train in the areas of hospice and home care, and much more.



UW OSHKOSH EARNS TREE CAMPUS USA

recognition for sixth year

Tree Campus USA, a national program launched in 2008 by the Arbor Day Foundation, honors colleges and universities and their leaders for promoting healthy trees and engaging students and staff in the spirit of conservation.



The Arbor Day Foundation named UW Oshkosh a Tree Campus USA for the sixth consecutive year in honor of its commitment to effective community forestry management.

UW Oshkosh achieved the recognition by meeting five standards for sustainable campus forestry required by Tree Campus USA, including establishment of a tree advisory committee, evidence of a campus tree-care plan, dedicated annual expenditures for its campus tree program and an Arbor Day observance, and the sponsorship of student service-learning projects.

The City of Oshkosh also has a Tree City USA designation, and the integration of the campus into the urban forestry program facilitates a community-wide forestry perspective that improves canopy coverage and environmental sustainability as well as providing enhanced benefit to citizens and visitors.

UW OSHKOSH *Football team* WELCOMES QUARTERBACK'S MATCH

In November, UW Oshkosh student-athlete Brett Kasper—along with the entire Titans football team—welcomed 10-year-old Phoenix Bridegroom, of Indiana, and her family to Oshkosh for a weekend of a lifetime.

Kasper, a junior studying supply chain management from Two Rivers, became unknowingly connected with the Bridegroom family in February 2015. He donated his bone marrow to a stranger—who happened to be Phoenix—through the Be The Match organization, which is a national nonprofit organization operated by the National Marrow Donor Program that manages the largest and most diverse marrow registry in the world.



With the help of the Oshkosh Convention and Visitors Bureau, the Bridegrooms met the Kasper family and attended the Titans football game against UW-La Crosse on Nov. 5.

Kasper became involved with Be the Match when Pat Cerroni, head coach of the Titans football team, rallied the young men to get on the Be the Match registry—something deeply important to him, as young men in Kasper's age group are the ideal donors. More than 80 percent of the UW Oshkosh Titans football team is now on the registry.

Because of Kasper's selfless donation, Phoenix remains in remission and continues to grow stronger every day. She is a thriving fourth grader and she is living her dream of being a "regular kid" who gets to go to school every day.

UW OSHKOSH BIOTECHNOLOGIST RECOGNIZED AS *Regent Scholar*

Toivo Kallas, a UW Oshkosh professor of microbial genetics and biotechnology, received a Regent Scholar grant to support his research in the critical effort to stem global warming at the UW System Board of Regents meeting in Madison in February.



Kallas was one of three recipients of the honor presented by the board's Research, Economic Development and Innovation (REDI) Committee.

"This program recognizes and honors outside-the-box thinking by UW faculty

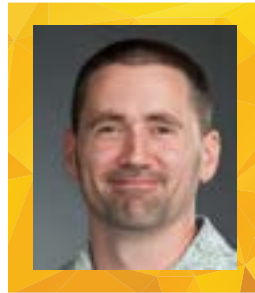
and undergraduates across Wisconsin," UW System President Ray Cross said. "The Regent Scholar grants provide recognition at the highest level for work done by our dedicated and talented faculty to prepare a high-quality workforce and ultimately to accelerate business and community development statewide."

Kallas received a \$50,000 grant for his work involving bioengineering of a newly discovered, ultra-fast-growing cyanobacterium for enhanced carbon capture and chemicals production. This work has critical global economic and ecological implications as 2015 was the warmest year on record.

"Carbon dioxide emissions from combustion of fossil fuels is a principal causative factor of global warming and climate change. The urgent need to address climate change and its dire consequences was underscored in the 2014 United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change," Kallas explained.

Kallas' grant project will enable undergraduate students at UW Oshkosh to engineer and characterize an ultra-fast growing cyanobacterium (blue-green algae) for carbon conversion to isoprene, a precursor for synthetic rubber, pharmaceuticals and biofuels. The project will jump-start development of the ultra-fast alga, which will accelerate algal strain engineering and progress toward commercially viable industrial carbon dioxide capture by carbon conversion to high-value chemicals.

FACULTY *Speaker***M. RYAN HALEY**

PROFESSOR, COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

M. Ryan Haley has taught at UW Oshkosh since 2004, serving as chair of the economics department from 2012 to 2015. He currently chairs the University Budget Development Committee, where he is working on development and implementation of a new University budget model.

Haley's teaching evaluation scores are at or near the top of his department. One student said, "In the classroom, he succeeded in grabbing my attention and drawing me into the complexities of an intermediate level economics class. He shaped my future by inspiring me to attend graduate school for economics."

In December 2011, Haley completed a large-scale federal grant designed to improve statistics learning outcomes while simultaneously reducing textbook costs. He also completed a two-year Federal Department of Education grant, which supported the development of a peer-reviewed, core-concepts, in-house-authored, electronic textbook with professor-specific appendices for economics and business statistics. Because of the grant, students saved more than \$140,000 relative to new textbook costs. Within three additional semesters of use, student savings will be more than the total grant award—an excellent example of how a grant can create an enormous amount of savings for current and future students.

Haley received his doctorate in economics from the University of Iowa.

Travis Cardarella, of De Forest, graduates from UW Oshkosh with a major in communication studies and an emphasis in organizational communication. Cardarella has been involved in variety of activities during his time at UW Oshkosh. As a freshman, Cardarella was involved in the American Sign Language Club and College Democrats. He also was active as a student leader in the Odyssey Program, a member of the Rainbow Alliance for Hope and in Habitat for Humanity, which informed his knowledge of environmentalism and sustainability. During Cardarella's junior and senior years, he joined the Millennials Club, focusing on the perspectives and experiences of millennials. He is the current president of the club, which was voted the best new student organization in 2015-2016. He also joined the CEO Club his senior year to learn more about entrepreneurship within the millennial generation.

"Graduation doesn't only reflect what we've done but also where we will be going ... the purpose we will continue to serve out," Cardarella said.

Following graduation, Cardarella plans to move to Madison and work in the nonprofit sector.

Karlene and Dennis Leatherman are the executive directors of the Oshkosh Saturday Farmers Market Inc. They have been active participants, volunteers and managers, helping lead this transformative community event.

The Oshkosh farmers market began in 1994 with a handful of pioneering growers and vendors setting up at Division Street and Church Avenue in Oshkosh. The market moved to the Oshkosh City Hall parking lot in 1998. The Leathermans became involved in 2004 and then joined a committee to help modernize the market's operations in 2007.

The market's growth was unmistakable, evolving from a small Saturday gathering of 10 to 20 vendors to more than 50 in 2010. The Leathermans remained fixtures of the market, steadfastly donating their weekends to coordinate promotion and volunteer setup. They would later step forward to officially manage the market.

The farmers market moved to North Main Street in Oshkosh in 2011, and its popularity has continued to grow. It has been recognized as one of the most vibrant in the nation, with Saturday participants eclipsing 12,000 people. More than 130 vendors regularly participate. The Leathermans' tireless commitment to the market's evolution has earned them awards from the City of Oshkosh, Oshkosh Chamber of Commerce, the Southwest Oshkosh Rotary and the Oshkosh Convention and Visitors Bureau.

The Leathermans commitment to sustainability and building a stronger community is unmistakable. Like the growers their selfless service has benefited, they have helped cultivate and nurture what has become one of Event City's jewels.
