ACCELERATED OPTION
REFUND POLICY - ADDENDUM

The UWO CON is in compliance with the University of Wisconsin System and University of Wisconsin Oshkosh refund policy.

The unique nature of the accelerated option requires an additional addendum due to its cost recovery nature and specialized administrative semesters. A nonrefundable deposit is due within two weeks of the student being offered placement in cohort. The balance of tuition is due in successive semester payments as outlined below and is based upon the schedule determined by the financial aid office for each specific cohort. Students are provided the timeline of payments upon offer of admission.

Students in the accelerated option do not pay on a per credit basis but on a block program payment basis. Students sign a document when entering the program acknowledging they understand the payment process for the program.

If a student withdraws from the program, regardless of the reason, after beginning courses in an administrative semester, the student is required to pay for the entire block administrative semester regardless of how many courses were actually completed in the administrative semester. However, the student will not be required to pay for block administrative semester(s) that follow the withdrawal. The table below illustrates the refund policy. The block tuition is charged in the earliest session of the semester and UW System Policy 805 will be followed looking at the first session of the term.

| Administrative Semester 3 | Withdraws prior to beginning of course date and prepaid all or part of administrative semester 3 – 100% of the prepayment. The nonrefundable deposit and tuition paid for semester 1 and 2 are not refundable. | Withdraws after first course begins or later – 0% |
| Administrative Semester 4 | Withdraws prior to beginning of course date and prepaid all or part of administrative semester 4 – 100% of the prepayment. The nonrefundable deposit and tuition paid for semester 1, 2, and 3 are not refundable. | Withdraws after first course begins or later – 0% |
