SPRING	(CNP) Nursing 447 – Leadership and Management (3cr) (UWO) Nursing 449 – Clinical Synthesis (4cr)

PART TIME (6 Credits): Spring Start – 3 Semesters and 2 Summers	
SPRING	(UWO) Nursing 324 – Orientation to Clinical Major (1cr) (CNP) Nursing 407 – Foundations of Professional Nursing Practice (3cr) (CNP) Nursing 492 – Pathophysiology OR 491 – Clinical Pharmacology (3cr)
SUMMER	(CNP) Nursing 453 – Information Management and Healthcare Technology (3cr)
FALL	(CNP) Nursing 441 – Chronic Care Management (3cr) (CNP) Nursing 446 – Research and Evidence-Based Practice (3cr)
SPRING	(CNP) Nursing 454 – Community Health Nursing (3cr) (CNP) Nursing 447 – Leadership and Management (3cr)
SUMMER	(UWO) Nursing 449 – Clinical Synthesis (4cr) <i>** Delayed if elective courses are needed/no certifications</i>

120 credits must be earned to complete a baccalaureate degree at UW Oshkosh. A minimum Combined GPA of 2.5 is required.
Pre-Nursing courses and nursing courses must be a C or higher (C- or lower are not accepted)
