      1. **COLS**: Computer Science – Create new Major – Software Technology [pp 377-390]
      2. **COB**: Analytics Minor – Create a new minor. [pp 391-397]
      3. **COB**: Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) – Changing the pre-professional core courses for COB. (Remove MATH 204) [pp 398-401]
      4. **COEHS**: MS Transnational Human Service Leadership – Change the name of the program from Masters of Science Transnational Human Services Leadership to Masters of Science Human Services Leadership. [pp 402-404]
      5. **COLS**: Foreign Language – Allow the completion of ASL 404/604 to meet the requirement for the Bachelor of Arts degree. [pp 405-408]
      6. **COLS**: Master of Social Work – *Mental Health Concentration* – Remove PRF CNSL approved electives for the emphasis: PRF CNSL 701, PRF CNSL 729 and PRF CNSL 730. [pp 409-412]

18. **COLS:** Journalism Major – *Emphases within Major: All: Advertising, Writing/Editing, Visual Journalism, Media Studies, & Public Relations* – Change Journalism major to Multimedia Journalism; eliminate the following emphases: Public Relations, Writing/Editing, Visual Journalism, and Media Studies; require courses to the Multimedia Journalism major; and change the requirements of advertising emphasis. 19. **COLS:** Journalism – Change name of Journalism minor from Journalism to Media Studies; change required class to JOURNAL 141, 221, 251, & 324 and four electives for 12 credits; and reduce number of electives from five to four to remain at 24 credit hours. [pp 477-480]
20. **COLS:** Journalism – *Advertising* – Change the core requirement of JOURNAL 239 or 251 to just JOURNAL 251. [pp 481-484]
21. **COLS:** Journalism – *Multimedia Journalism* – Create a minor with the following: JOURNAL 141, 221, 251, 324, 327, 331 and two electives. [pp 485-487]
22. **COLS:** Journalism – *Public Relations Major* – Change JOURNAL 239 or JOURNAL 251 to just JOURNAL 251; change JOURNAL 239 or JOURNAL 331 to JOURNAL 331 or JOURNAL 452; and change JOURNAL 250 to JOURNAL 250 or JOURNAL 327. [pp 488-491]
