Independent Study Guidelines: Primarily departments offering graduate degree programs have course listings for Independent Study. An Independent Study provides an opportunity for degree-seeking or post-master's students to study, under faculty supervision, an area of interest which is not available in the curriculum. The following apply:		
 Registration for a graduate-level Independent Study is open to students who are admitted in full standing in a degree program or who have already earned a master's degree. Graduate "Special" or "Non-degree" students are not eligible to engage in an Independent Study. Each credit earned for Independent Study should represent the equivalent of at least 50 clock hours of work. Registration in an Independent Study is separate. This registration is subject to the same add/drop policies as all other courses. Only one Independent Study (3 credit maximum) contract is permitted per student in a term. No more than 6 credits of Independent Study credits may apply to a degree.
