Recommended Course Sequence:

Freshman: INFO SYS 151, CS 125, BUS 198, and USP

Sophomore: JOURNAL 221, CS 142, INFO SYS 311, and USP

Junior: MARKET 371, INFO SYS 350, INFO SYS 352, JOURNAL 340, CS 247, CS/JOURNAL, and USP

Senior: MARKET 363/MARKET 428, BUS 488, JOURNAL 440, and CS/JOURNAL

Suggested courses to fulfill the additional 24 Computer Science and/or Journalism courses; 9 of 24 must be upper level (300/400): BA and BS Students are not limited to choose from one department's offerings, but can mix and match from either department, excluding courses required in the IWM major.
