FIRST YEAR

*First year students need to satisfy their USP (general education) requirements. Many Political Science courses are USP courses, so students can start their major while completing USP requirements. Political Science 101 (GC, SS, QII); Political Science 105 (SS, QII, QIII); Political Science 115 (GC, SS, QII) are required for the major and satisfy USP requirements.
