

Graduate HCM Curriculum for Students Admitted prior to Fall 2013

The Graduate Certificate in Health Care Management consists of 15 credits.

- Students must complete 9 credits from Category A.
- Students must complete 6 credits from Category B.

Category B (6 credits)

- ECON 368/568* Health Care Economics (3 credits)
- BUS 700 Foundations of Accounting (both financial and managerial) (3** credits)
- BUS 710 Foundations of Information Systems (1.5** credits)
- BUS 730 Finance Foundations (1.5** credits)
- BUS 750 Organizational Foundations (1.5** credits)
- BUS 770 Foundations of Marketing (1.5** credits)
- MPA 742 Human Resource Management in the Public Sector (3 credits)
- MPA 750 Strategic Planning in Public and Non-Profit Organizations (3 credits)

Note:

- *Prerequisite courses for ECON 568 are economics 206, or 208 or consent of instructor.
- **Credits may vary if taken online.
- The HCM certificate must be completed within four years.
- Other Business Administration courses may fulfill Category B requirements.
