Decision

The Curriculum and Program Array Working Group met on June 13, 2018 and has made the following recommendations regarding the conferral of Associate degrees at the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh access campuses:

The Associate of Arts and Science degree as it is currently offered on the UW-Fox Valley and UW-Fond du Lac campuses will remain in effect through the 2019-2020 academic year. Students admitted through Spring 2020 will follow the current Associate degree standards as outlined in UWC Senate ICP#101. Courses that are offered in service to this degree will continue to be offered through Summer 2025 on the access campuses.

Background

Rationale:
 The Curriculum and Program Array Working Group has identified Fall 2020 for launching updated Associate degree standards that would both align to UWS policy and reflect the regional restructuring of the access campuses with UWO. The working group is currently analyzing alignment between the UWC "reimagined" Associate's degree standards, the UW Oshkosh University Studies Program, and UWS Administrative Policy 115 as a first step in this process.
