Rationale: A well-functioning IRB exists at UW Oshkosh, and the UW Colleges IRB and their federal				
wide assurance will be dissolved, following the restructuring. The Access campuses have no other mechanism to oversee work involving human subjects research at this time. Use of the current UW				
Oshkosh IRB for oversight of any human subject research on the Access campuses is the most efficient
