Decision

UW Oshkosh Institutional Review Board (IRB) (and all approved procedures, forms, etc.) should oversee use of human subjects in teaching and research at the Access campuses.
Timeline: Immediately

Background

Details: UW Oshkosh has a well-established IRB, OHRP federal wide assurance, and associated compliance staff to oversee use of human subjects in teaching or research on campus.
Rationale: A well-functioning IRB exists at UW Oshkosh, and the UW Colleges IRB and their federal wide assurance will be dissolved, following the restructuring. The Access campuses have no other mechanism to oversee work involving human subjects research at this time. Use of the current UW Oshkosh IRB for oversight of any human subject research on the Access campuses is the most efficient way to proceed. See Recommendation #4, concerning representation on the IRB.
Additional Info: Kelly Schill, Anca Miron, and Kristi Wilkum (IRB Administrator for UWC) have been working together to transfer current IRB protocols and close finished IRB protocols from the Access campuses. New submissions to the IRB will use UW Oshkosh forms and follow the UW Oshkosh IRB review process. The Access campuses may affiliate with the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh to utilize the CITI Program training for human subjects research.
