Decision Title:	Increase Student Life at the FDL Campus

Recommended Decision

Increasing outreach and recruiting student athletes for the access campuses will help to retain students (providing additional extracurricular activities). The newly implemented Amtrak throughway service will allow for athletes from Milwaukee (for example) to be recruited to play sports on the access campuses. Having the new Amtrak option will provide greater opportunities for students and families to travel to and from the Oshkosh University campuses to their home town.

Background

An increase of 0.50 FTE in the Athletic Director position will allow for increased outreach and recruiting opportunities for access campus athletics.
