

Wisconsin Council on Social Work Education Scholarship Award Application

The WCSWE Scholarship Award is a financial award designed to provide support to students pursuing a professional social work degree, funded from contributions of social work faculty throughout Wisconsin. The scholarship is also designed to encourage and recognize excellence in volunteerism, scholarship, creative thinking, and writing.

Two Awards of \$750 will be offered: one for MSW students and one for BSW students of member Schools of Social Work.

The deadline for submission of applications is March 20, 2020. Scholarship awards will be determined by March 27, 2020 and recipients will be notified via email.

The electronic application packet should include your resume and student statement. Reference letters should be electronically submitted separately by the identified references.

- ✓ Resume including Employment and Education History, Email Address, Name of School and Academic Program)
 - ✓ Student Statement (Please limit your response to two single-spaced pages)
 - A. Describe your employment history and non-required volunteer work in your community.
 - B. List any relevant organizations that you have been a member of including the dates, and activities that you were involved in. Describe any honors received, offices held, etc.
 - B. What are your career goals? Be specific in how your goals demonstrate your commitment to social work.
 - C. Please describe any unusual circumstances that have adversely affected your financial status and ability to fund your education.
 - ✓ 2 Letters of **Recommendation from** Faculty Member, Work or Volunteer Supervisor
- Applicants must be attending a WCSWE member Social Work Program for the 2020 Spring semester in order to receive the scholarship award.*
