



# Roger E. Guiles Leadership Scholarship *Application*

Nomination forms for the Roger E. Guiles Leadership-Scholarship Award are available in the Office of Student Affairs, Dempsey 148 or on the Student Affairs website: <https://uwosh.edu/student-affairs/>

The award is made yearly to a full-time student in their fourth semester at UW Oshkosh who has exhibited leadership in student activities (excluding athletic participation\*) and good scholarship (as reflected in G.P.A.), and who most notably represents a reflection of the ideal (gestalt) of the University. The applicants must have demonstrated a) the ability to work within the system, and b) leadership in attracting other students to become positively involved in campus-wide activities.

Students must be nominated for this award. Self-nominations are not accepted.

The award consists of a scholarship of approximately \$1000 to be applied as a credit against the recipient's fall and spring semester tuition in 2022-23. Nominations may be made by students, faculty, or staff of the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh.

3. The applicants must have demonstrated a) the ability to work within the system, and b) leadership in attracting other students to become positively involved in campus-wide activities.
4. Financial need is not a crucial criterion for this award.

As noted above, the qualifications for this award require evidence of leadership consistent with the ideal of the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh, the ability to work within the system, and experience in attracting other students to become positively involved in campus-wide activities.
