

Title IX and Sexual Misconduct

Section I

Reporting to the University

UWO students can disclose any sexual misconduct to any UWO employee to get connected with the Title IX Coordinator for support and options. ALL UWO employees, except for the TWO campus resources listed below in Section II (page 2), <u>must report a student disclosure of sexual misconduct to the University Title IX Coordinator</u>. The Title IX Coordinator's contact information is listed below.

Reports made to the Title IX Coordinator are not reported to law enforcement with a victim/survivor's name, but other information about sexual misconduct (crimes) will be reported as required by the Clery Act.

UWO students can also report to law enforcement. UWO has a University Police Department located on the Oshkosh campus. The Fox Cities and Fond du Lac campuses can report to University Police and/or local law enforcement. Reports made to University Police are reported to the Title IX Coordinator/University.
