Pregnant & Parenting Title IX – Know Your Rights

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 ("Title IX"), 20 U.S.C. §1681 et seq., is a Federal civil rights law that prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex—including pregnancy and parental status—in educational programs and activities

Absences/Make – Up Work

Absences for pregnancy or childbirth are excused. Students are allowed to complete all work missed and make up any class participation points (if applicable.)

Choice

Students are allowed to continue participating in classes and extracurricular activities as they wish during pregnancy – without doctors' notes.

Adjustments

Students may request for adjustments to accommodate pregnancy. This may include larger desks, changes to schedules, elevator access, etc.

WI Statute 253.165 Right to Breast-feed

Allows a parent to feed their child in any public or private location where they are otherwise authorized to be.

Breast-feeding is included as a pregnancy and childcare related condition.
Instructors and student will collaborate on reasonable adjustments and allow for make-up of any missed coursework.
