Selection & Requirements

Application Requirements:

- Must be a current resident of UW Oshkosh residence halls
- Must currently be an enrolled student
- Must currently be a third year student
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Must at some point have been involved in a residence hall organization (Hall Government, USRH, NRHH, etc.)
- If currently a CA, only items ABOVE AND BEYOND the job description may be included
- May not be a previous recipient of the Katie Kaczorowski, Tyler Feldkamp, or One Small Step Leadership Awards

Criteria for Selection:

- Activities, Honors, and Awards (50%)
- Completed Essay (30%)
- Two Recommendation Forms (20%)
 - One from a peer
 - One from UW Oshkosh faculty or staff

Deadline:

- Completed application materials should be submitted online by **Friday, April 3, 2020 at 11:59 PM** to usrh@uwosh.edu with “Leadership Awards” as the subject line.
- The recipient of this award will be announced at the USRH Pre-Awards Ceremony on Thursday, April 30, 2020 at 4:35 PM.
